- 2. Please focus on the activities and the accomplishments of the nominee, rather than their personality. Assume that all nominees could be described as helpful, fun to work with, or enthusiastic. Spending more than 1-2 sentences detailing the personality of the nominee will not help to distinguish your nominee from the other nominations submitted.
- 3. Please nominate a single individual. Dual or team nominations are discouraged, unless there is a particularly compelling reason to do so (i.e. you are nominating two family members, who work and contribute as a team).

Scoring Criteria for Oregon State Master Gardener of the Year

Applicants will be scored, based upon the criteria outlined below (50 points possible):

- 1) Number of Years as a Master Gardener (5 Points): For every TWO years of service, nominees will be awarded ½ point, up to 5 points, total.

- **2)** Number of Hours of Master Gardener Volunteer Service (5 Points): For every 100 hours of service over the LAST FIVE years of the nominee's Master Gardener career, ½ point will be awarded, up to 5 points, total.
 - Hours Volunteered in the last FIVE years of Oregon MG Career = ____ hours

- **5) Impact (15 Points):** The statewide Master Gardener of the Year is someone who has impacted volunteers, beyond the borders of their own county or regional Master Gardener Program. In 2-3 paragraphs, please describe the nominee's impact on the Master Gardener Program, at large, via the development of novel programs or approaches. Programs and approaches are considered IMPACTFUL, if other County Master Gardener Programs have adopted them. Programs and approaches may also be considered IMPACTFUL if they have significant and positive change (in knowledge, attitudes, or behavior) in other Master Gardener volunteers, or in the public that we serve.

 - Small-Scale Impact, that has resulted in a change in a local Master Gardener
 Program = 1-5 points
 - Impact that has resulted in change in multiple Master Gardener Programs Across the State = 6-10 points
 - Impact that has had positive effects across the entire Oregon Master Gardener
 Program = 11-15 points

- A long-term and regular supporter of the Master Gardener Program, whose work often goes unrecognized (e.g. lead work on special projects that are not often seen by the other volunteers or the general public) = 11-15 points
- **5)** Comments from Extension faculty and staff (5 points). The comments from the staff are important and independent support for each nominee. If you are not able to get comments from the Extension Master Gardener coordinator in your county, please ask another Extension faculty or staff member who knows the nominee to provide comments. Examples of other faculty or staff members who might provide comments include: the statewide Master Gardener coordinator; Extension county coordinator; Extension Master Gardener administrative or educational program assistant; Extension Regional Director.
